Drop off & pick up arrangements

Since the routines for dropping the children off and collecting at home time are going so well we are going to adjust the times to reduce the amount of time between groups. **From Monday** the times will be:

Please remember that adults are required to socially distance at all times so at home time we ask that you move right into the zone where your child will be brought to by their teacher, keep a safe distance from others (2 meters) and keep the path clear (where the spots are). This is to allow a clear entry and exit path for yourself and others. Only one adult should be coming onto site with your child, again this is to maintain social distancing.

With new restrictions coming in for the North East because the rate of infection is rising, I cannot stress strongly enough that we all need to follow the guidelines in place to keep everyone safe.

Breakfast Club

I am looking into the practicalities of restarting Breakfast Club. This would be open at 8am but we do not have a start date yet. This would **be available for parents** <u>who need it</u> <u>due</u> **to work commitments only** and would not be open to all pupils at the moment due to COVID restrictions.

To help with planning for this please could you let the office know if your child would need a space and if this would be for the full week or certain days (please let us know which days). The cost is 50p per day and we would need to know in advance if your child was attending.

Any changes that we make in school will be for trial periods, and will be kept under constant review, both from a school point of view and in line with any advice from local or national government.
