They develop their understanding of how religious beliefs are expressed in practice by studying how worship takes place in the mosque. They build on earlier work on religious experiences and expression, and on previous experiences of visiting religious buildings PE Use running, jumping, throwing and catching in isolation and in combination. Develop flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance [for example, through athletics and gymnastics]. Introduce the children to the core task - Distance challenge. Ask the children which skills they will need. Put children into 4 groups (see core task card). Watch how the children play and perform the skills; Running - 5 secs, 30 secs 2 min timed, Jumping - standing long / triple jumps-measured, Throwing - howler / tennis ball throw-measured.
