Literacy	Reading Writing Com and lang	In Early Years this term we have completed our own story maps based on the Three Billy Goats gruff. We have thought about our likes and dislikes of different stories including the Gruffalo and Stick Man. We have used our phonic knowledge to write some simple CVC words to match our stories.
Mathematics	Numbers Shape, space and measures	In Early Years this term we explored 6, 7 and 8. We have compared amounts and used our knowledge to begin some addition calculations. We have completed a shape hunt and compared lengths of sticks and found pairs in outdoor learning. We have explored capacity using liquids and difference resources in our homes.
Physical Development	Moving and handling Health and self-care	We have played lots of games at home with our families, done on bike rides and completed lots of walks. We have played different games from Get Set 4 PE including Capture the Socks, Alphabet Walk and Hamster Wheel. We have also enjoyed doing lots of dancing.
PSHE / SMSC / RRSA	Making Relationships Self-confidence and self-awareness Managing feelings and behaviours Peoples and Communities.	We have thought about our likes and dislikes in our local area and could give reasons for our answers. We have talked about our friends, completed drawings of them and said why we miss them and school right now. We took a vote on a story we could listen to and most people chose Strick Man, learning a little democracy.
Science	The world (Understanding the world)	In Early Years this term we have studied some of the local area, completing walks to find local landmarks and also locating them on Google map. We also took part in the RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch this term.
Geography	The world (Understanding the world)	This half term we have explored the local area and commented on our likes and dislikes, giving reasons for our answers.
History	Peoples and communities (Understanding the world)	This term we have explored similarities and differences to our parents. We have identified that sometimes we have different hair and eye colour to our parents.
ICT	Technology (Understanding the world)	We have thought and explored online safety through the story of Clicking Chicken. We could tell our adults how we should stay safe online. We have used Google Maps to locate different landmarks including mining statue 'Marra' and our school.
