Subject	Subject Summary
English	Our English sessions have been based on adventure stories this half term. We have used a model text 'Alien Abduction' to base our writing on. We have created powerful openings and have written our own timeslip. We have improved our understanding of clauses main and subordinate and can explain the subject and objects in sentences.
PSHE/SMSC/RRSA	Changing me has been the topic this half term. We have had mature discussions about the changes that happen to our bodies as we grow and how changes are different between males and females. We have enjoyed learning what we see as the perfect girl or boy and realise that these qualities are different for everyone.
Maths	We have mastered fractions this half term. We began using shapes and pictorial representations to find halves and quarters and quickly moved on to finding fractions of amounts. We developed our knowledge of fractions very quickly and can now add and subtract fractions with the same denominator as well as identifying equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.
RE	The children have worked hard this half term on what they know about Christianity. They have been able to identify the belief, the authority, expressions of belief and the impact of their belief within the Christian religion. This has enabled them to reflect on their own beliefs and values.
D&T	Designing playgrounds has been so much fun for us this half term. We used a design criteria to plan our own playground. We used a range of materials to make a climbing frame and a swing. This has helped us improve our measuring, cutting and joining skills by using a range of tools to build our finished designs.
Geography	In Geography we have developed our knowledge of our own country and the wider world. We know the planet is made up of continents and oceans and can name these. We can name the countries that make up the UK, the surrounding seas and some capital cities.
Music	We have been learning about the history of music this half term. We have enjoyed exploring the history of music and can use some musical language accurately.
Computing	In computing this half term, we have had great fun designing our own games. We have become experts in logical reasoning. We have used purple mash to create a game using different outputs. (swipe or click). We can move a sprite around a screen and make objects disappear.
MFL	The children have tried hard in Spanish this half term, they have enjoyed learning the Spanish alphabet and can identify some of the sounds to spell out words. Their pronunciation is developing well and they can ask questions and give answers.
Science	Our science topic has been evolution and inheritance this half term. We have begun to understand the theory behind evolution and how living organisms are believed to have developed. We understand that offspring can inherit different traits from their parents.
PE	Calling the shots has helped us to improve our ball control skills. We have had lots of fun practising dribbling a ball with control and increasing our speed. We can attack and defend an area have improved our passing skills where we can pass longer distances. We have also had some swimming sessions. We are becoming more confident in the water.
