






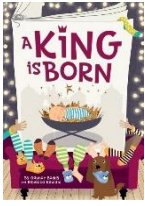


Dear Parents and Carers,

The children will be busy in the coming weeks so here are the dates of events that we have organised.

<p>Friday 1st December</p> 	<p>For our Winter Enterprise each class has been given a loan and they have to think of things that they can make and sell, hopefully making a profit. This is a very valuable lesson teaching the children about the world of work, using initiative, teamwork and financial capability so please show your support.</p> <p>All items are made by the children and will cost no more than £1 each.</p> <p>You are invited to come into school on Friday 1st December from 2.20pm (Reception, Years 1 & 2) then 2.45pm for Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 in order to buy the items alongside your child. Some children will also be running the stalls.</p> <p>If you are not able to come in on the Friday and would like your child to be able to buy something, please send the money into school and we will make sure they have the opportunity to buy before the fair starts.</p> <p>The children will then get to decide what they spend their profit on. Previously the children have bought things for their classrooms or have donated to a charity of their choice.</p>

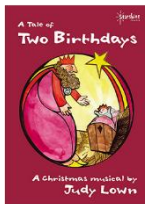


The children in **KS1 (Reception, Year 1 & 2)** will be performing their Christmas Nativity 'A King is Born' at 2pm.
