The children will have a fantastic half term focusing on a range of texts linked to penguins and Antarctica. Our non-fiction focus this half term is to create an information poster. The children will complete research on a chosen animal and will create fact files to show what they have found out.

Their narrative will focus on the story Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers and look at the lovely friendship that blossoms between the boy and the penguin. Throughout the half term, we will practise handwriting where we will focus on letter formation and the size of our letters. The children will work on developing their description using their senses and adding detail using adjectives. (Describing words).
