English text types Core text: Wolf Brother-Michelle Paver Each week we are going to use Vipers to study each chapter of the text and practise the following skills. V-new vocabulary. I-inference skills. P-make sensible predictions based on the text. E-explain. R-retrieve information in order to answer questions. S-summarise each chapter. Week 1-2: We will start by looking at our new river topic. The children will learn the geographical vocabulary associated with rivers and begin to learn the model text for an information text. They will produce a poster to develop description and persuasion vocabulary. Week 3: Poetry week - Haiku. The children will learn the main rules for writing a haiku (3 lines, 5 syllables each line). Week 4-7: We will then focus on narrative and our new story, 'Ice Forest'. We will look at the different features of an adventure/quest story and what makes a good setting. The children will write their own adventure/quest story based on all of the work we have done. They will describe, sequence and investigate the simple functions and the basic parts of the digestive system in humans and they will identify and name the different types of teeth in humans and some other animals, and their simple functions. Children will understand how their teeth could decay and how they could keep teeth healthy. They will have constructed and interpreted a variety of food chains and will have identified the producer, predator and prey. Working Scientifically, children will have the opportunity to set up simple enquiries and fair tests, asking questions and using different types of scientific enquiries to answer them. They will have compared and contrasted human and other animal dentition. They will have conducted an investigation on tooth decay substituting eggshells as a close representation of human teeth.
