Core text: Zog - Julia Donaldson and other stories which feature dragons and dinosaurs. Story type: Meeting tale Focus: Description Model text: The Somethingsaurus Film unit: Adventures are the pits The children will have an amazing half term focusing on a range of texts including Zog - Julia Donaldson and other stories which feature dragons and dinosaurs. We will look at developing the children's ability to write simple sentences including a capital letter, finger spaces between each word and full stops. Throughout the half term, we will practise handwriting where we will focus on letter formation and the size of our letters. Our model text, 'The Somethingsaurus' is an interesting text about a mystery animal that hatches from an egg and experiences the world for the first time. The children will work on developing their description using their senses and adding detail using adjectives. (Describing words). Non-fiction text type: Recount Non-fiction model text Zog at school The children will create recounts of Zog's first day at school focusing on all the different activities that Zog completed and comparing them to their own experiences.
